

How to Measure Your Ring Size at Home

If this box measures 1" your print is to scale.

Using a Ring You Already Own:

1. Start by printing this guide with page scaling set to 100%.
2. Select a ring you already own that offers a secure yet comfortable fit for the desired finger.
3. Place the ring you wish to measure on top of the circles shown to the right and carefully match the ring's interior to the circle that's nearest in size. The corresponding measurements shown indicate the inside diameter of the ring.

Using a String to Measure Your Finger:

1. Wrap a piece of string or floss around the base of your finger. Keep in mind that string and floss can stretch, so try not to pull your measuring tool too tight.
2. Mark on the string where it first overlaps on your finger using a pen or marker.
3. Measure the length from the start of the string to the pen mark with a ruler, taking down its length in millimeters.
4. Take your millimeter measurement and match it to the circles shown on the right, which will indicate the corresponding ring size. Every half ring size equates to a 0.4 millimeter increment, starting with size 3 equaling 14.1mm.

PLEASE NOTE:

- This printable guide is intended to serve as a reference, and we recommend that you order our free plastic ring sizer for a more accurate measurement. Get your complimentary ring sizer at [borsheims.com/find-your-ring-size](https://www.borsheims.com/find-your-ring-size).
- Make sure to consider width when choosing a ring size. The wider the band, the tighter it may feel, meaning you may need to go up by a half size.
- If your measurement falls between sizes, order the bigger size. Some rings may be available to order in quarter size increments.
